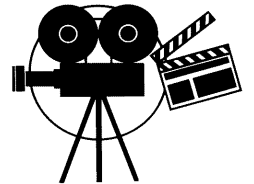

Additionally, the event will honor Oakland film writer and business consultant, Gini Graham Scott, who has a half-dozen film deals with producers and agents, has a service that connects screenplay writers to the film industry, and will be giving a workshop at the Film Festival on "How to Connect with Film Producers, Production Companies, and Agents."
